STATISTICAL REPORT

Fiscal Year 2022

CENTER ADMISSIONS:

From **January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022**, there were **473** admissions to the **Northwestern Minnesota Juvenile Center (NMJC)**. **181** of those admissions were re-admissions.

Of these **473** admissions, **366** were non-status offenders, **86** were status offenders, **17** were CHIPS and **4** were EJJ.

There were **273** youth admissions to the Non-Secure Detention Unit (NSDU); of which **10** were later transferred to the Residential Treatment Unit, and **3** youth were later transferred to a Satellite Home.

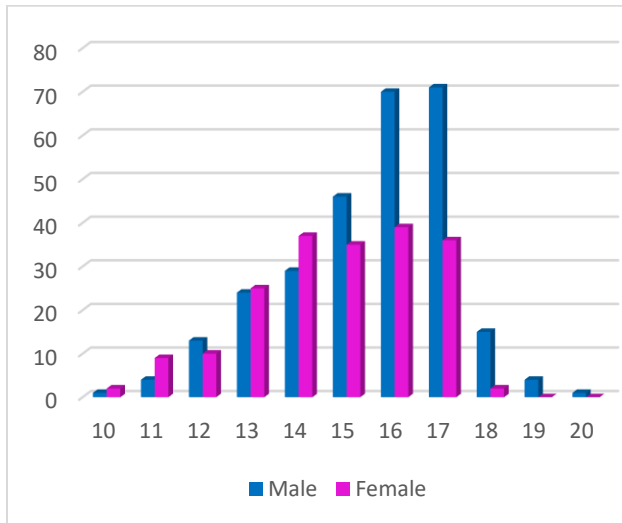
There were **191** delinquent youth admitted to the Secure Detention Unit (SDU); of which **16** were later transferred to the Residential Treatment Unit, and **4** youth were later transferred to a Satellite Home.

There were **18** NSDU youth court ordered to complete a 35 Day Evaluation and **4** SDU youth were court ordered to complete a 35 Day Evaluation.

There were **4** youth admitted directly as commitments to the Residential Treatment Unit (RTU); and **5** youth were admitted directly to a Satellite Home. Residential Treatment Unit transitioned **11** youth to the Satellite Homes, of which **1** was a current year NSDU admit, **2** were current year SDU admits, and **8** prior year admits.

Of all admissions **195** were born female and **278** were born male; of these the **median age** at the time of admission was **14.5** for females and **15.0** for males.

Age at Admission by Gender

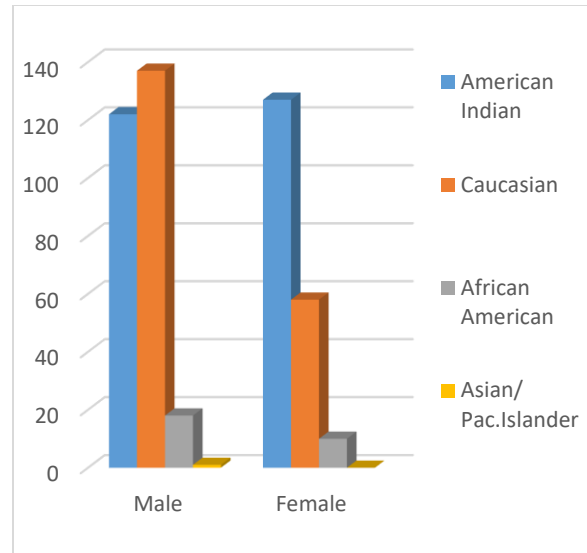

Of the **278** males admitted, **122** of the males were American Indian; **137** were Caucasian; **18** were African American; and **1** were Asian/Pac. Islander. Also **22** of these males identified as Hispanic.

Of the **195** females admitted, **127** were American Indian; **58** were Caucasian; **10** were African American; and **0** were Asian/Pac. Islander. Also **27** of these females identified as Hispanic.

For both males and females, **249** identified as American Indian; **195** identified as Caucasian; **28** were African American; and **1** were Asian/Pac. Islander.

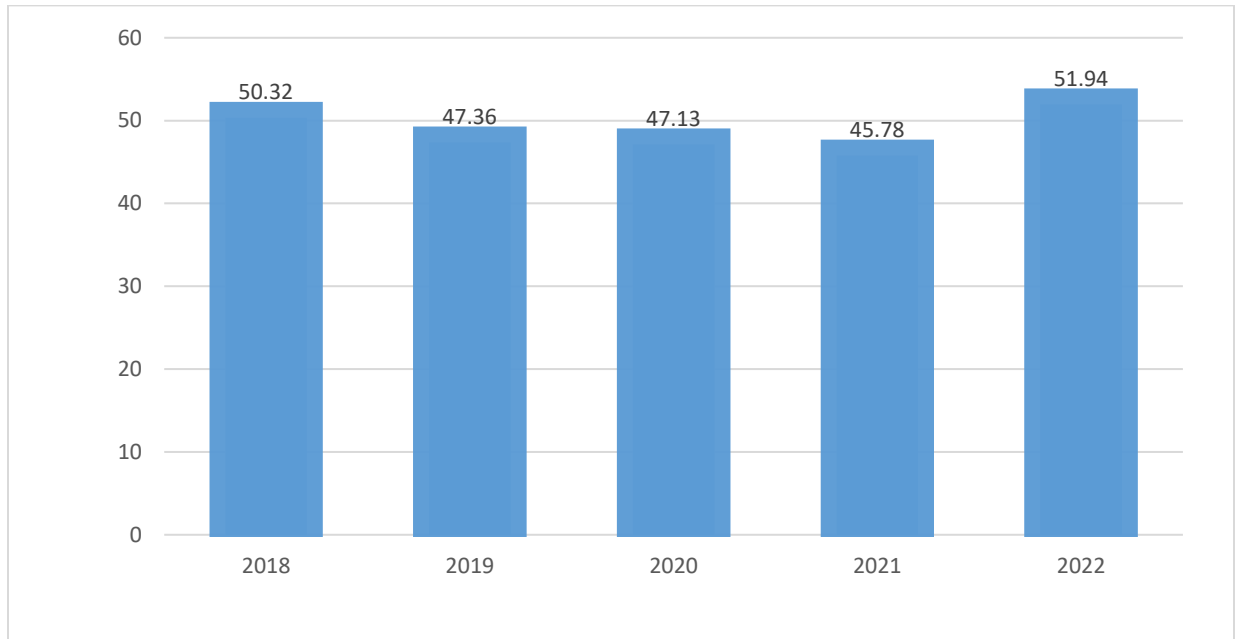
