NORTHWESTERN MINNESOTA JUVENILE CENTER STATISTICAL REPORT

Fiscal Year 2023

CENTER ADMISSIONS:

From January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023, there were <u>487</u> admissions to the **Northwestern Minnesota Juvenile Center (NMJC)**. <u>265</u> of those admissions were readmissions.

Of these $\underline{487}$ admissions, $\underline{393}$ were non-status offenders, $\underline{85}$ were status offenders, $\underline{7}$ were CHIPS and $\underline{2}$ were EJJ.

There were <u>317</u> youth admissions to the Non-Secure Detention Unit (NSDU); of which <u>9</u> were later transferred to the Residential Treatment Unit, and <u>3</u> youth were later transferred to a Satellite Home.


There were $\underline{153}$ delinquent youth were admitted for closed-setting confinement in the Secure Detention Unit (SDU); of which $\underline{9}$ were later transferred to the Residential Treatment Unit, and $\underline{3}$ youth were later transferred to a Satellite Home.


There were <u>13</u> NSDU youth court ordered to complete a 35-day evaluation program and <u>3</u> SDU youth were court ordered to complete a 35-day evaluation program.

There were <u>12</u> youth admitted directly as commitments to the Residential Treatment Unit (RTU); and <u>5</u> youth were admitted directly to a Satellite Home. Residential Treatment Unit transitioned <u>2</u> youth to the Satellite Homes, <u>1</u> was current year SDU admits, and <u>1</u> prior year admit.

Of all admissions <u>210</u> were born female and <u>277</u> were born male; of these the **median age** at the time of admission was <u>15.36</u> for females and <u>16.05</u> for males.

Of the **210** females admitted, **130** were

American Indian; <u>67</u> were Caucasian; and <u>13</u> were African American. Also <u>33</u> of these females identified as Hispanic.

Of the <u>277</u> males admitted, <u>117</u> of the males were American Indian; <u>128</u> were Caucasian; and <u>32</u> were African American. Also <u>21</u> of these males identified as Hispanic.

For both males and females, <u>247</u> identified as American Indian; <u>195</u> identified Caucasian; and <u>45</u> were African American.


