STATISTICAL REPORT

Fiscal Year 2023

CENTER ADMISSIONS:

From **January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023**, there were **487** admissions to the **Northwestern Minnesota Juvenile Center (NMJC)**. **265** of those admissions were readmissions.

Of these **487** admissions, **393** were non-status offenders, **85** were status offenders, **7** were CHIPS and **2** were EJJ.

There were **317** youth admissions to the Non-Secure Detention Unit (NSDU); of which **9** were later transferred to the Residential Treatment Unit, and **3** youth were later transferred to a Satellite Home.

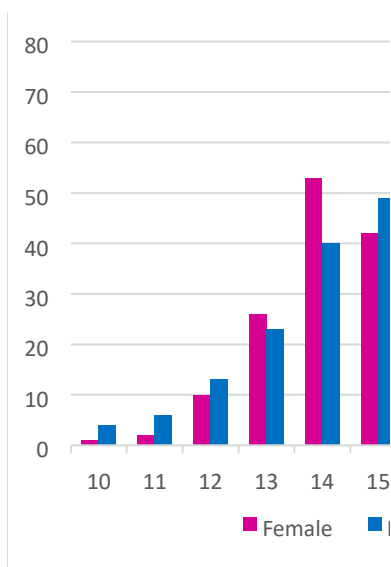
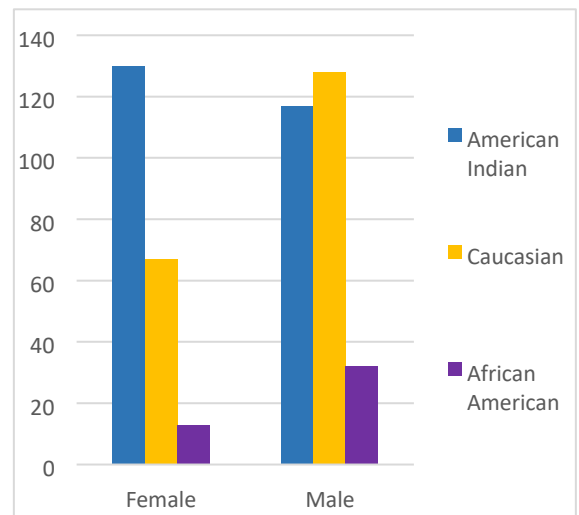
There were **153** delinquent youth were admitted for closed-setting confinement in the Secure Detention Unit (SDU); of which **9** were later transferred to the Residential Treatment Unit, and **3** youth were later transferred to a Satellite Home.

There were **13** NSDU youth court ordered to complete a 35-day evaluation program and **3** SDU youth were court ordered to complete a 35-day evaluation program.

There were **12** youth admitted directly as commitments to the Residential Treatment Unit (RTU); and **5** youth were admitted directly to a Satellite Home. Residential Treatment Unit transitioned **2** youth to the Satellite Homes, **1** was current year SDU admits, and **1** prior year admit.

Of all admissions **210** were born female and **277** were born male; of these the **median age** at the time of admission was **15.36** for females and **16.05** for males.

Of the **210** females admitted, **130** were

American Indian; **67** were Caucasian; and **13** were African American. Also **33** of these females identified as Hispanic.

Of the **277** males admitted, **117** of the males were American Indian; **128** were Caucasian; and **32** were African American. Also **21** of these males identified as Hispanic.

For both males and females, **247** identified as American Indian; **195** identified Caucasian; and **45** were African American.

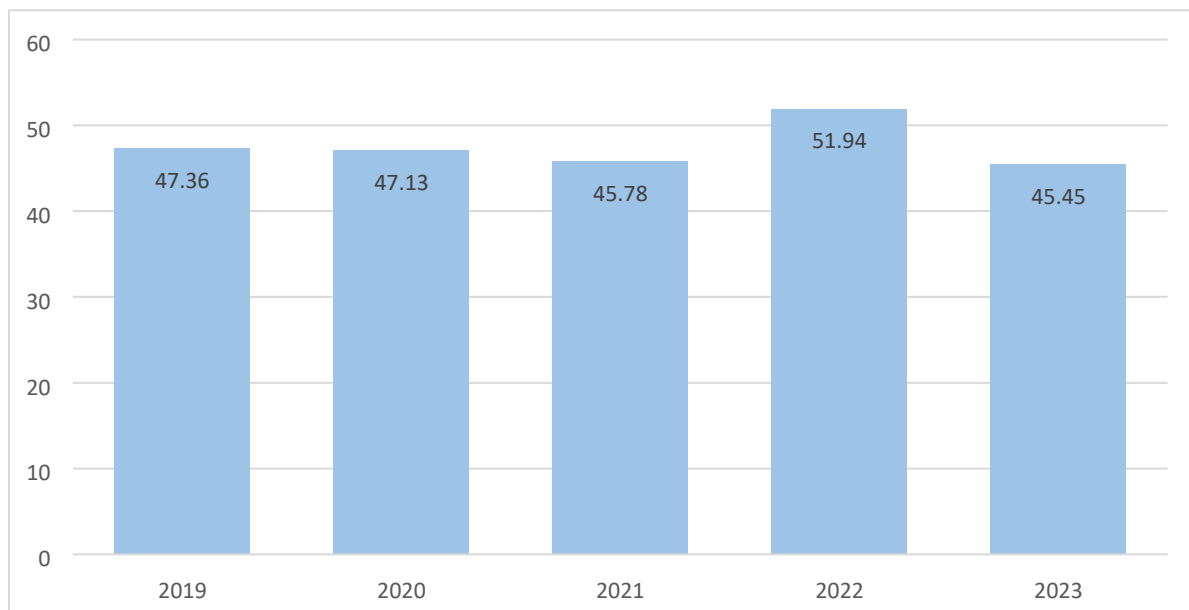
